



New band students or those requiring help come at 9:30 am for additional instruction at no extra cost which allows new students to join year round. Students will play with the band for public performances when they are ready, but may join at anytime to start their instruction.



We also break the band into sectionals to allow the groups to get more focused instruction, and peer mentoring.



For performances we allow students the opportunity to share what they are most proud of with solos, ensembles, duets, trios, etc. This allows sections, siblings, and friends a chance to show off what they have learned and created together.
